*Ch Kiamichi Walker Texas Ranger – Ch Shears' Belle of the Ball*

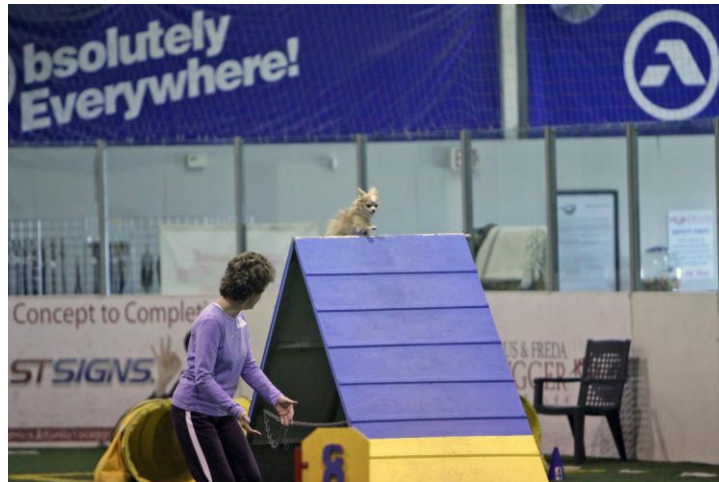

*Casey was born on June 28th, 2002, a single puppy. At 8 weeks of age and with the loss of our 19 year old "house dog Rowdy", he quickly became the center of attention in our house. At 10 weeks of age he could walk on the edge of his dog bed and I knew he could be my performance dog. We started formal obedience training when he was just a little over a year of age and agility training about 6 months later. Casey earned both his CD and Rally Novice title in 2005 as well as his Novice and Open Agility titles in AKC and his Agility I and Agility II titles in UKC. We continued in agility and added Teacup Agility to our competition.*

*In 2006, Casey earned his AKC Open and Open Preferred titles, his Teacup Beginner title, his Teacup Games 1 title, his UKC CD, and UKC Agility Champion and Agility Champion Excellent titles. In Jan 2006, Casey lost his biggest fan, my MOM. She loved to watch him run and was always there to encourage us no matter if we qualified or not. But we gained a "best friend" in Ramona Stanfield and her Rat Terriers. We have become traveling companions and best friends.*

*In 2007 our abilities as a "team" continued to improve. As AKC times are so difficult for the small breeds, we elected to compete at the "preferred level" for a while which allowed Casey to jump at 4" and gave us 5 additional seconds to complete the course.*



*"A Big Climb for a Little Dog"*

*Casey earned his Agility Excellent Standard title and Excellent Jumpers title the same weekend in Dec 2007. In 2007 he also earned the UKC Grand Agility Championship title and was invited to compete at the UKC Premiere as an agility All Star in all three levels. Agility is his passion and I believe that he could do it everyday.*

*In 2008 Casey finished his Rally Advanced Excellent title and he finished his AKC Master Agility and Master Agility Jumpers titles at the preferred height and moved back to his regular division of 8" in the fall and finished his Excellent Agility Jumpers title in Dec. During 2008 Casey also earned several additional UKC Grand Championship titles and placed 4th in the Agility III competition of the All Stars He also completed his Teacup Superior title, Teacup Games 3 titles, his Teacup Master Agility title, Teacup Master Agility Games title and his Teacup Agility Championship title.*

*In Jan of this year Casey finished his Agility Excellent title and now we are working to complete his Master Agility and Master Agility Jumper titles. He also earned a third invitation to the UKC Premiere as an AGII and AGIII All Star.*

### *Rally & Agility Terms*

#### *Rally:*

*RN – Rally Novice*

*RA – Rally Advances*

*RE – Rally Excellent*

*RAE – Rally Advanced Excellent (requires a qualifying score in both RA & RE at the same trial a minimum of 10 times)*

#### *AKC Agility*

*Novice & Novice Preferred (Standard & Jumpers) - Level – (requires 3 qualifying scores) – NA, NAP, NAJ, NJP*

*Open & Open Preferred (Standard & Jumpers) – Level 2 – (requires 3 qualifying scores) – OA, OAP, OAJ, OJP*

*Excellent & Excellent Preferred (Standard & Jumpers) – Level 3 – (requires 3 qualifying scores) – AX, AXP, AXJ, AJP*

*Masters & Masters Preferred (Standard & Jumpers) – Level 4 – (requires 10 qualifying scores) – MX, MXP, MXJ, MJP*

*MACH – requires 750 points (1 point is earned for each second under the course time) and 20 Double Q’s (qualify in both standard and jumpers on the same day)*

*PAX – requires 20 Double Q’s from the Masters Preferred Level*

#### *UKC Agility*

*AGI – Level 1 (3 qualifying scores)*

*AGII – Level 2 (3 qualifying scores)*

*UACH – Level 3 (100 points earned from AGI & AGII –requires a score 196 or higher out of 200 to earn points)*

*UACHX (AGIII) – Level 4 (5 qualifying scores of 196 or above under 3 different judges)*

*UGRACH – Grand Championship Level – requires a qualifying score in AGI, AGII & AGIII in the same trial (with a cumulative score 588 or better) 5 times*

*NJC – Novice Jumpers*

*NCC – Novice Chances*
